Pray the Bible for a Year is designed to guide you through 365 days of Scripture-based prayers. Each day, you will find a Bible verse followed by a prayer inspired by that verse. To make this journey personal, a blank line is included in each prayer where you can fill in the name of a child, grandchild, sibling, parent, spouse, loved one, or even yourself. You may choose to pray for the same person throughout the year, or ask the Holy Spirit to bring someone different to mind each day.

As you pray through the Scriptures, you will find that it's not about finding the perfect words, but about allowing God's Word to shape your prayers. With each prayer, your faith will deepen, and you'll experience God's wisdom in new ways, knowing that His truth applies to every part of your life.

January 1
